- Same copies of the site






#### **Pantheon Standard Workflow**








#### **Pantheon Standard Workflow**

## Environment and Fork



#### Environment

Infrastructure for a site, including code, DB, and files.





## Environment and Fork



### **Environment**

Infrastructure for a site, including code, DB, and files.



#### Fork

Copy source code to start independent development. Pantheon also copies files and database when forking.


## Terminology

- environment: Independent infrastructure for a site, including code, DB, and files.
- ▶ fork: To divide in branches, copying source code to start independent development. Pantheon also copies content (files and database) when forking.
- commit: Record snapshot to history.
- branch: Movable pointer to a set of commits, allowing independent development and history.
- master: Name of default branch; deployed to Pantheon Dev, Test and Live environments.
- merge: Combine contents of a branch into another, like a bug fix branch into master.
